

## Ben Cornett Receives 2006 Stanley C. Lott Award First Manufacturer to be so Honored

Ben Cornett became president of Honeywell Security in November 2002. Before joining ADEMCO in 1995, Ben held the position of president and CEO of Intellisense, and executive vice president of Blue Grass Electronics. Ben's first entry into the manufacturing business was with Solfan Systems in 1980. The company later became C&K Systems.

In 2004, Ben was also honored by being named to the "Security Industry Hall of Fame" and designated as one of the 25 "people who shaped the industry" over the past 25 years.
