AMPS Carrier Shutdown Dates Update

Dear Valued Customer,

Across the USA, the cellular industry is transitioning the traditional AMPS (Analog) networks to digital networks. As part of Honeywell's commitment to notify you of developments, listed on the following page are the anticipated AMPS Network shutdown dates. AlarmNet-C series radios must be replaced before the AMPS shutdown dates, as they will no longer be operable following such dates.

To help you manage and transition your customer base from AMPS radios (Honeywell radio part numbers 7835C series and 7845C series) to Honeywell's GSM series radios, AlarmNet Direct has added new information to the "**View Accounts**" page, which can be viewed at:

The additional information includes:
