Objective:

This 3-day training course is intended for installers, service technicians, and administrators of Pro-Watch Video Management Systems together with integrated Pro-Watch Professional or Corporate system server.

The training focuses on the planning, installation and maintenance of the Pro-Watch Video management suite (Maxpro VMS) as well as the integration of the Pro-Watch Access Management suite.

At the end of the course all students will receive a "Documents and Tools" software package which contains Product documentation, product related tools, presentations, and a fully operational Pro-Watch Video Manager Trial version.

Training session Duration

The time period to be reserved for this training session is 3 days, where the 1st 2 days are reserved for VMS product training and the 3rd day for Pro-Watch integration training. Each day will have (2) intermediate breaks and a lunch. Hot and Cold drinks will be available throughout the entire course, and a complimentary lunch will be available.
